

PROVISIONAL YARINA BIRD LIST

Compiled August 1998 by Steve N. G. Howell and Sophie Webb

The following is a list of species of birds that have been recorded in the vicinity of **Yarina**, a new lodge on the south bank of the Rio Napo, and due to open in 1999. This list is based primarily on three days of field work in August 1998 (courtesy of an invitation from Don Fernando Sanmigeul) and is therefore very incomplete (e.g., several trails have yet to be cut). It does give some idea of the high potential for this site (e.g., we recorded 200 species in three days, mainly in one forest type!), most of which is *terra firme* forest, much of it relatively hilly. There is also a small river (Sungrebe, kingfishers, etc.), plus an area of secondary forest which, when accessible, will greatly increase the bird list. There are several trails already cut and these enable access to good forest right around the lodge.

Yarina is less than an hour by canoe from Coca, unlike other lodges which are several hours, and when you reach the lodge via 15 minutes along a small river, you step off the canoe right at the lodge, making it very easy to access. There are also good mammals and butterflies here – in three days we saw Red Howlers, Monk Sakis, and Squirrel Monkeys really well, plus fresh tapir tracks. Tinamous were common and we actually *saw* four species!

The lodge is being built by Don Fernando Sanmiguel, who also owns and runs **Yuturi Biological Reserve**, another excellent birding area with much varzea and terra firme forest and a bird list approaching 500 species. Don Fernando is deeply concerned about protecting the forest and the operation is family-run by Ecuadorians, rather than by foreign businessmen.
